## **Existing Development**

Council will, if it considers necessary, exercise its powers under Section 124 of the Local Government Act to create the necessary easements to permit the installation of pipes and fittings to drain surface or roofwater. The actual works involved in installation shall then be the responsibility of the beneficiaries which may include Council. All works to be carried out to Council's specification and under Council's supervision.

## **New Developments**

Council will exercise its powers under the Local Government Act to provide the necessary easements and installations to drain new developments and adjoining existing developments. This function will form part of the planning approval process associated with development applications.
